## **Program Summary**

This program features a Mock Trial displaying the skills of barristers of the Bar of England and Wales and Fellows of the American College of Trial Lawyers.

The case of the day is Lynn Rogers v. Metal Fabricators, Inc. Ms. Rogers, represented by English barristers, claims she was wrongfully discharged because she refused the sexual advances of her boss and former fiancé Alex Goodings.

Metal Fabricators, Inc. ("MFI"), represented by Fellows of the College, claims that Ms. Rogers was terminated because she was deficient in her job performance.

The audience will be composed of Fellows of the College, guests, and members of the English Judiciary and Bar. All will gain insight into the differences between trials in each country, the skills of each country's trial lawyers, as well as differences between the judges of each country in the conduct of trials. Following the trial a panel will convene to highlight points of interest, and engage in questions and answers with the audience.

A jurist from the United States and a jurist from England and Wales will jointly preside over the trial. Six jurors and an alternate will be selected from the audience.
